## UC DAVIS BASEBALL HALL OF FAME

- I. Statement of Purpose
  - a. To enhance UC Davis and the UC Davis Baseball program.
  - b. To honor selected former UC Davis Baseball players and coaches.
  - c. To pay tribute to distinguished achievement both on and off the playing field.
  - d. To re-establish ties with former UC Davis Baseball players.
  - e. To honor special service to the UC Davis Baseball program.
  - f. To maintain camaraderie of those associated with UC Davis Baseball.
  - g. To elicit continued identity and support for the UC Davis Baseball program.
- II. Selection Criteria & Guidelines for an Athlete
  - a. The nominee's baseball career achievements will comprise 60% of the criteria.
  - b. The nominee's business/professional achievement, as well as his civic and community service, will comprise 20% of the criteria. The nominee must have achieved success after UC Davis sufficient to be considered a role model for future UC Davis baseball players.
  - c. The nominee's academic achievements will comprise 10% of the criteria. Graduation from UC Davis will not be a litmus test, but solid academic achievement will be.
  - d. The nominee's overall contributions to the UC Davis Baseball Program after the nominee's playing career will comprise the final 10% of the criteria.
- III. Selection Criteria & Guidelines for a Coach
  - a. Seasonal records
  - b. Conference, District or National Coach of the Year recognition.
  - c. Significant professional recognition.
- IV. Selection Criteria & Guidelines for a Team

The team must have made an unusual or significant record of achievement.

- V. The Nomination Process
  - a. Nomination forms requesting player nominations and information will be sent by mail to all UC Davis Baseball alumni and friends by October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
  - b. A deadline for all nominations will be set for no later than November 30<sup>th</sup> of each year.
  - c. In order to qualify for nomination, a player must have waited a minimum of ten (10) years from the time his collegiate athletic eligibility expired.
- VI. The Selection System and Logistics
  - a. The Delphi Analysis System of subjective evaluation will be used in the final selection of the candidates (see attachment).
  - b. Final Selections may be announced as early as December 15<sup>th</sup> of each year, but in any event, no later than January 1<sup>st</sup> of the following year.
  - c. Selections will be made on a yearly or every-other-year basis at the discretion of the Selection Committee.
- VII. Material Required for Each Nominee
  - a. Nomination form filled out completely (see attached).
  - b. One or more page summary of qualifications.
  - c. Letters of recommendation, in support of the nominee, from:
    - 1. Individual making the nomination.

- 2. At least one additional letter of support from the following:
  - Athletic Director Sports Information Director Dean Faculty Member Coaching Staff Teammate Current close associate

VIII. The Selection Committee

- a. The Selection Committee will be composed of respected observers of UCD Baseball who have a broad view of the history and traditions of the program.
- b. After a minimum of 12 individual members are inducted, then those 12 inductees will compose the Selection Committee.
- IX. The UC Davis Baseball Hall of Fame Induction Banquet
  - a. The Induction Banquet will be held generally in March on Saturday evening.
  - b. Inductees will be notified by December 15<sup>th</sup> of each year and will be given opportunity to choose the individual to introduce them in receiving their award.
  - c. A suitable guest speaker will be invited to keynote the event.
  - d. Inductees will receive a plaque commemorating their induction and duplicate plaques will be displayed prominently inside the press box at Dobbins Stadium.
  - e. In order to receive the UC Davis Baseball Hall of Fame award, inductees must be present at the ceremony.
